

2017 Show Season
IdRHA Youth Scholarship Guidelines

1. Applicant must be a current IdRHA member in good standing and youth eligible for the 2017 Show Season. 14 - 18 age group is eligible to apply.

2. This application is due to the IdRHA Youth Director no later than December 1, 2017. You will be contacted for an interview.

3. All applications will be reviewed by the Board of Directors and a collective decision will be made.

4. An essay is a requirement of this application. Please see page 2 of the application for topic. Essay should not be less than 1 full page, but no more than 2 full pages, double spaced.

5. Scholarship will be awarded at the 2017 Show Season Year-End Awards Banquet scheduled for January 2018. All checks will be written to recipient's school of choice on their behalf. Under no circumstances will the funds be sent to the youth. The youth will be responsible for providing all pertinent school contact and mailing information to the IdRHA Treasurer. All scholarship monies will be held until the recipient is ready/able to use them for schooling. If the IdRHA has not been notified of intended use within 5 years of award, those funds will again be made available to another youth.
